



1582- What does this number and the below photos have in common???





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Residence East Development, pictured above, behind lower Puerto Drive and Stonehouse Park, received the go-ahead for water hook-ups from the Rancho Murieta Community Services District (CSD) at the August 21 Board Meeting. This 3:2 vote of approval came much to the dismay of 1,582 water district residents who have signed a Petition to declare a Moratorium on development until the Integrated Water Master Plan (IWMP), currently under development, is completed and verified. In our opinion, this approval was totally irresponsible and quite possibly poses a threat of limited water supply and storage capacity to our current residents. Preliminary review of the IWMP is very clear that our water supply and storage capacity is questionable under present climate conditions and likely to get worse in the future, particularly in drought years, and..... drought years are inevitable, we all know this.

So, perhaps what is done, is done, but please **SAVE THE DATE**, September 18 @ 5:00 at the CSD Bldg. for the next CSD Board Meeting where SOLOS will officially present our 1500+ Petitions and recommend that the CSD Board do the responsible thing. **Declare a water emergency!** Declaring a water emergency has been mapped out for the CSD Board by their legal counsel. It is the appropriate action to protect what precious water we have and limit the imminent threat until possible options can be explored and developed.
